## REPORT ROUNDE TABLE Law on Strike Action

05/09/2018 we organized rounde table about "Law on Strike Action" this Law present the proffesor Ivo Rozić.

On the round table, their active participation was taken by employers, trade union representatives, and representatives of the ministries. In addition to their participation, other interested parties were also involved. On the round table was attended by 28 participants.

The professor presented the new version of the law to the participants and said that: "The draft law on strike represents the improvement of legislation in this important area. The applicable strike law is scathing, incomplete and inaccurate and obviously does not meet the needs of this time. The proposed draft law on strike, although it could not accept all the remarks of all participants, is a document about which there is a very high level of harmonization between social partners. Furthermore, by analyzing its content it can be said that it meets the standards laid down by relevant international acts and, above all, in the context of the interpretation of the provisions of the Convention."

The professor stresses that the Law on Strike Action will bring:

- Harmonization with international conventions and EU directives
- Increase peaceful settlement of labor disputes
- Reduction of the number of strikes
- Harmonization of regulations.
